

LINEAGE RESEARCH WORKSHEET

Although each society has its own rules and procedures, central to all of them is the requirement that you provide the birth, marriage, and death dates and places for each of the line carriers between you and your eligible ancestor. You will also need documentation to prove the connections between the generations. A fact worksheet can help you stay organized and will highlight any holes in your research.

Worksheet Instructions:

- 1. Begin with the ancestor who qualifies for the lineage society, and then list all the generations between that ancestor and you. Use as many pages of the worksheet as you need. Also include the information for each line carrier's spouse.
- 2. Fill in as much of the birth, death, and marriage information as you know, and list the source for each fact. Indicate where dates are approximate: i.e. circa 1780.
